Direction

From Cookeville: Travel Hwy 111 South. Take US-70 / Smithville ramp to Sparta. Turn left at US-70. Travel approximately 1.9 miles then turn left on N. Highland Drive and arrive at the Rescue Squad Building.

From Crossville: Take US-70 W toward Sparta. Turn Right at N. Highland Drive and arrive at the rescue squad building.

From McMinnville: Take US-70 N toward Sparta. Merge onto US Hwy 111 and travel North. Take US-70 / Sparta ramp toward Sparta. Travel approximately 1.8 miles then turn left on N. Highland Drive and arrive at the Rescue Squad Building.
